ITEMS NOT ALLOWED FOR PICK-UP

Effective February 1, 2003, the Hueytown Street Department will not pick up items that are not biodegradable. (Ordinance No. 03-0114-1) Residents must dispose of non-biodegradable items themselves. (This does not affect household garbage pick-up by ALLIED WASTE)

The City will only pick up the below-listed "trash":

Tree trunks that are no longer than three feet in length

Tree limbs that are no longer than six feet in length

*Leaves and grass clippings in biodegradable bags

*Leaf-vacuuming: From November through March, Leaves and debris will be vacuumed from the street rights-of-way of elderly citizens or those in poor health (Res. No. 3186)

No items or debris generated by a contractor or generated by residents doing similar work to their own residences will be picked up by the City.

No trash pick-up service will be offered to households not in compliance with City ordinances regarding garbage service and garbage fees.

Orange notices will be left on doorknobs where non-biodegradable items are left by the roadside telling the resident that they must remove the items from the premises within seven (7) days.
